FEE: Camp fee is \$440 (Transportation is expected to be an additional \$130 – dependent upon attendance) per scout for the general merit badge program, which most scouts attend. All fees include camp registration, camp T-shirt and nightly cracker barrel. All forms MUST be completed by the meeting on Monday, March 31st by turning in to the completed permission slip, merit badge request form and \$100 deposit to Mr. Butterfield. You can also send a scanned copy of the forms to (ckbfield@gmail.com). Final camp fee balance is due no later than May 8th. NOTE: Some merit badges require additional fees.

RETURN: We will return Saturday, June 24th, details to follow

ATTIRE: All scouts must have on the full Class A uniform, in order to depart with the troop for Summer Camp. Scouts who arrive without the complete Class A uniform will be sent home to retrieve the missing item(s).

WHAT TO BRING TO SUMMER CAMP

(MAKE SURE EVERYTHING IS LABELED WITH THE SCOUT'S NAME)

- [Foot Locker \(lockable\) with Wheels](#). Husky 25 Gal. rolling toolbox – Home depot. No duffle bags or luggage please as clothes may get wet.
- Sleeping bag with pillow. (It can get cool at night)
- Sleeping Pad
- Small day pack or book-bag. To carry Merit Badge Books and personal items
- Class A Uniform (includes bolo-tie, scout belt & socks and OA sash)
- Troop 1011 Class B T-Shirts (2-3) - You can purchase additional shirts and you will get a new one on Wednesday at camp if you take a shower
- Long Pants (preferably nylon) and long sleeve T-shirt for 1st year scouts taking swimming MB.
- Shorts (3) - Scout uniform shorts if you have them.
- Underwear (5 at most, 4 will come home clean)
- Socks (2-3 pair Scout socks, 3+ other socks)
- Sleeping wear, PJs.
- Swim Trunks and Towel (pack last on top for easy access)
- Sturdy Shoes (hiking boots). 1st years will be taking 5-mile hike during week.
- Tennis shoes (1 – 2 pair) as they may get wet.
- Inexpensive wristwatch (use alarm to wake up and be to class on time)
- Insulated plastic mug with handle and name on bottom (troop will not bring cups)
- Water Bottle (Nalgene type bottle) THIS IS A MUST!!
- Toilet Kit with toothbrush, soap, shampoo, and towel wash cloth etc.
- Shower shoes, Crocs etc. Note for shower only, only closed toed shoes in camp
- Jacket or windbreaker (gets cool at night in mountains)
- Poncho or rain suit (ANOTHER MUST!!)
- Flashlight/Headlamp (2 types of light is preferable), extra batteries
- Pocket Knife, only if have Totin Chip (no sheath knives, switch blades, blades over 3 inches)
If scout is going to earn totin chit at camp, knives are taken by scoutmaster when loading bus and handed out after the scout earns his chit.
- Personal First Aid Kit.
- Sunscreen, insect repellent (non-aerosol)
- Notebook and pencils for MB classes.
- Merit Badge Books for class and Scout Book with plastic cover.
- \$30 - \$40 spending money or extra money needed for merit badge items.
- Hanger to hang up uniform.
- Compass
- 25' of clothesline (hang up towels, swimsuit, etc.)
- Personal reading material, cards, games, Frisbee football.
- Landry bag for dirty clothes. (Hopefully, this will be used before the last day)
- Scout Handbook

DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS

- No ELECTRONICS of any type (iPods, Cell Phones, Game Boys, Radios, TVs)
- Cell phones – scouts may bring – but must surrender when loading bus – limited cell service at camp decreases the usefulness at camp anyway.
- No Inappropriate Reading Material. (If you cannot show it to Mom, then do not bring it to camp)
- No aerosol cans of any type or Butane lighters.
- No junk food, snacks, candy, magazines, etc to sell to other scouts for profit.
- We will have a Cracker Barrel every night.
- Obviously!!! No Fireworks, Firearms, drugs, or alcohol.
